The assessment policy for this division ensures that both theoretical knowledge and practical skills are evaluated comprehensively to prepare students for the workforce or further education.

We assess:

- **General subjects:** Language, mathematics, science, sociology, and law.
- **Major technical subjects:** Field-specific knowledge and practical competencies.
- **Professional skills:** Communication, team building, problem-solving, time management, and safety practices.

How Do We Assess?

A. General Subjects

- **Formative Assessments:** Quizzes, class participation, assignments, and oral presentations.
- **Summative Assessments:** Written exams, research projects, and standardized tests.

B. Major Technical Subjects

- **Formative Assessments:** Skill demonstrations, quizzes, assignments, and instructor observations.
- **Summative Assessments:** Hands-on tasks, written exams, and projects.

Certification Exams

As part of the program requirements, students enrolled in the Technical Institute division are required to take Microsoft, Adobe, and Cisco certification exams relevant to their field of study. These certifications validate the students' technical skills and enrich their employment profile. Preparation for these exams is integrated into the curriculum, and students are provided with resources and guidance to succeed.
